

20th IUPAC International Symposium on Organometallic Chemistry Directed Towards Organic Synthesis

Travel Information

Travel to Heidelberg, Germany, for most international participants, will start with a flight to Frankfurt am Main (Frankfurt Airport, "FRA"). From the train station, which is directly located at Frankfurt Airport, the German Railway ("Deutsche Bahn") will first transport you to Mannheim Main Station ("Mannheim Hauptbahnhof") within 40 minutes. There you change to the local train "S-Bahn" to Heidelberg (another 15 minutes).

An alternative is the shuttle bus, again directly from Frankfurt Airport to Heidelberg, approximately 60-90 minutes traveling time, depending on the traffic conditions.

Participants from neighboring European Countries can also travel by train to Heidelberg main station ("Heidelberg Hauptbahnhof").

On short distance a travel by car can be an alternative, Heidelberg is directly connected to the German highway system ("Autobahn").

Within Heidelberg the hotels and the convention center can conveniently be reached from the train station ("Heidelberg Hauptbahnhof") within 5-10 minutes by public transportation (busses or tram). The train station is quite close to the hotels and to the convention center, a taxi ride should cost between 8 and 15 Euros. Participants can buy the Heidelberg Card which covers public transportation and reduces entry fees to museums.
